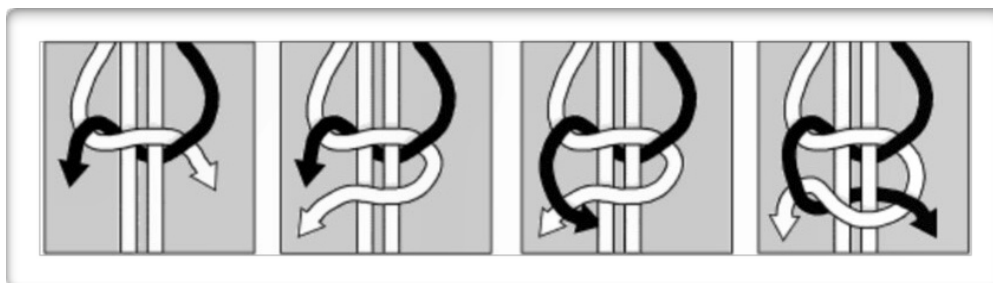
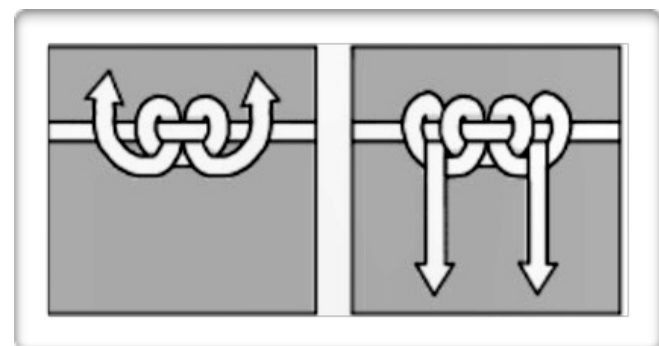
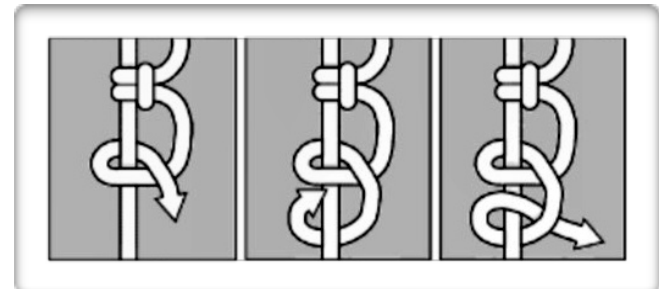
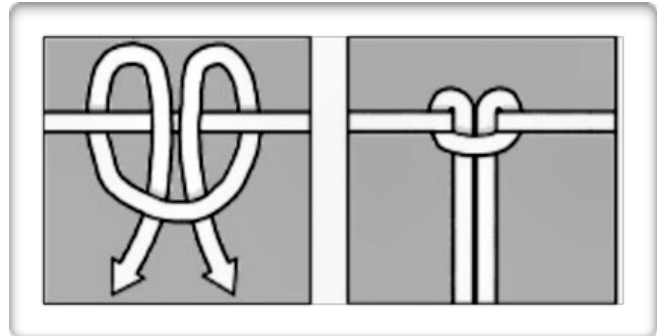


Useful Micro Macrame Knots!

Lark's Head Knot

Used to attach cord to a bar or ring to begin a project or end off a project onto a ring or bar. Also can be used as a decorative knot.

First Variation uses two ends,
Second Variation uses only one end.
The Third Variation is used to mount cords onto a bar or ring, then add another lark head to each side to create spacing between cords for knotting.



Square Knot

This knot can be used as a securing knot or as a decorative knot.

Overhand Knot

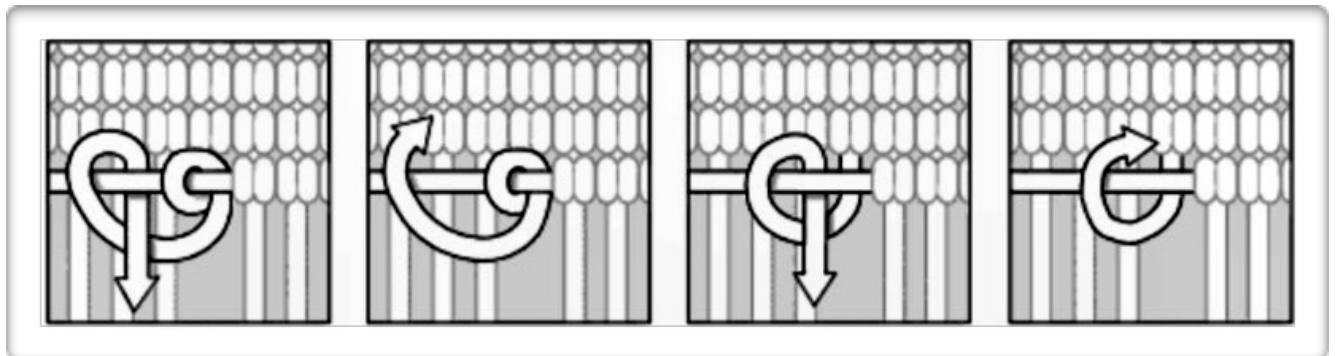
This knot is normally used as a securing knot or a stopper knot.



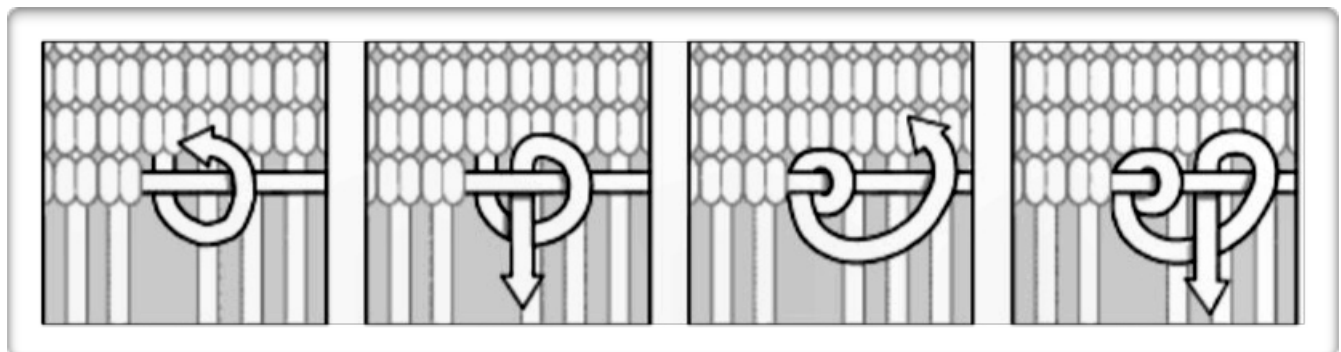
Double Half Hitch Knot over a Holding Cord

Used to create "ribbing" in macrame, these knots run across a holding cord passing over the top of a series of working cords.

Going Left....



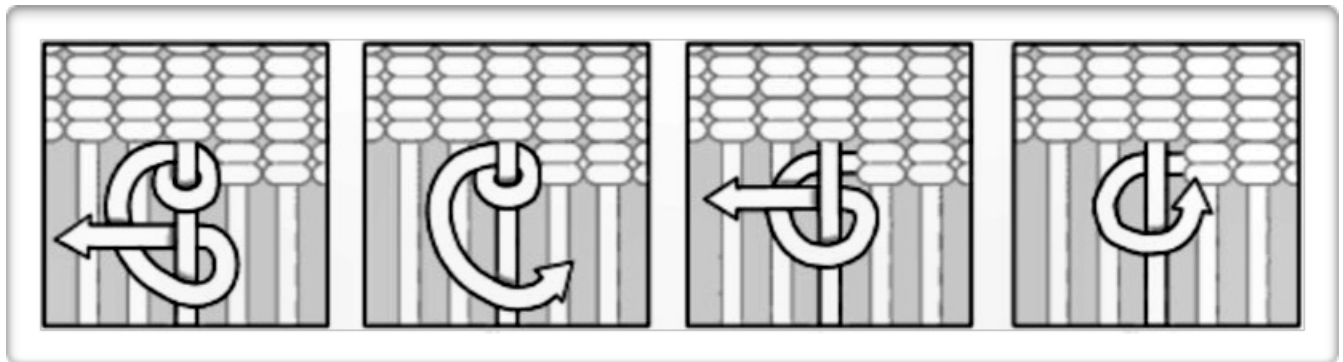
Going Right...



Vertical Double Half Hitch

This knot uses each vertical hanging cord as an individual holding cord, while the adjacent cord serves as the working, or knotting, cord.
